About:

Rajasthan had the seventh highest number of road accident injured persons in the country. In 2016, there were 23066 road accidents in Rajasthan, out of which 10644 were the fatalities. Solid action plan is required to reduce the road accidents. A joint efforts of all stakeholders need to be worked out for the noble cause of road safety.

Rajasthan Sadak Suraksha Society (RSSS) is a Society of dedicated Officers, comprise of well experienced Transport Officer, Advocates, Engineers, Doctors, Drivers, Trainers working on Road Safety. Society initiated its project with Hindustan Zinc Limited (HZL) in Nov 2012. Mr. Veerendra Singh Rathore is the brain child behind this unique project

1. Education & Awareness Sessions by Road Safety Mobile Van:

The society is imparting training & creating awareness to large no. of people including children residing in remote areas. The mission promotes road traffic rules and regulations for road safety. It identifies the black spots and work for accident free zone. It spreads road safety awareness among mass through its high teach road safety mobile van. Road safety education includes use of seatbelt, helmet, traffic rules, road signs & signal and also brief on good Samaritan as directed by Honourable Supreme Court of India.

Road safety education encourages and supports the role that parents and stakeholders play in helping their children to be safe road users and to learn about road safety. It seeks to develop the behavior and attitude for safe road use relevant to the development of children and young people as passengers, pedestrians, cyclists and drivers. The aim of road safety education is to reduce the risk of injury and death of children and young people from road trauma and to lay the foundations for safe road use throughout life. In Education Drive, Mobile Van plays very important role for spreading education awareness among people. Mobile Van takes session for the same. Mobile Van educated 52132 people by taking 519 sessions.

2. All India Meet: A meeting was conducted in Delhi on 29th April, 2016 with group of ministers and secretaries from all india transport department to discuss on how to Improve Road Safety and Ease of Transport. The panel and participants appreciated the efforts made by RSSS and wishes its success in the following years. Its road safety activities/workshops are fruitful and showed a positive response in the behaviour of road users.



3. Kumbh Mela : On 25th May 2016, members of society and transport department has took the support of religious people during the KUMBH MELA at Ujjain as road safety is concern to all. Team stayed seven days at KUMBH MELA and requested SANTS for spreading the road safety messages to common person. Team

also conducted workshop on road safety at camp of Swami Vamdev. Swami Anant Dev Mahamandaleshwar appealed the devotees to follow road safety procedures with citation of example of Mahabharat episode. Through these sessions 5000

beneficiaries were educated.



4. Most Safe School Award Campaign: From the past experience the society had noticed need to work in the field of child safety pertaining to prevailing school transportation. In the recent survey we found the following lacunae which need immediate address- School Staff Not Complying Road Safety Rules and Riding Vehicles without Helmet and License, Compliance of Bal Vahini Rules, No Safety Measures by Auto/Tempo Plying in the School, No Record of the Auto/Tempo in the Hired By Parents, School Children Riding Two Wheelers, Riding Two Wheeler by Senior Students without Helmet and a Valid Driving License, Activating and Strengthening Road Safety Clubs in Schools. To address this issue Rajasthan Sadak Suraksha Society formulated this project – Most Safe School Award.

Nov 2016-Jan 2017, Rajasthan Sadak Suraksha Society launched a pilot project of Most Safe School Award Campaign in Udaipur with collaboration of Udaipur Traffic Police and Rajasthan Patrika (Udaipur). Aim of this competition was to achieve Safe Transportation of School Children.

Traffic Police of Udaipur awarded the best schools awards for the following categories:

1. Most Safe School
2. Best Driver
3. Best Road Safety Club
4. Excellence Award

5. Baseline survey for analysing road users behaviour at 16 identified stretches : To provide Base line survey data, from the observations of the area on levels and types of activities associated with the road at all the stretches of 6 Locations including transport, commercial and social uses.

According to baseline survey approx. 87% road users are violating traffic rules and putting their life in risk. Different campaigns were conducted to educate and aware the road users for traffic rules and regulations. The impact of these road safety activities was visible in end line survey.

6. Stakeholders Meeting on road safety for sensitizing stakeholders : To sensitize all the stakeholder for road safety, vlock level meetings were organised. For reducing the road accidents rate in district, different aspects of road safety was discussed in detail to ensure the enforcement of rules and regulations along with the 6 E's planning, vehicles engineering, roads engineering, Emergency care after accidents was discussed.

Stakeholders are from Police, Transport, Health, Administration, PWD, NHAI, Education, Panchayat, Automobile Association, Public Representative, Corporate, NGOs, Media. Stake holder meeting was conducted at DARIBA in the Zinc Club Hall on 31st March 2017 with 84 participants. This comprises of participants from different departments like Police, Transport, Health, Administration, PWD, NHAI, Education, Panchayati Raj, Automobile associations, Corporates, NGOs and Media.
